1. Right click on the zip file containing the U-MYX
2. From the menu that appears, select 'Extract All'
3. Click 'Browse' and choose a location to unzip the U-MYX to (choose 'Desktop' if you are unsure)
4. Click the 'OK' button to close the 'Browse' window
5. Click the 'Next' button to unzip the files
6. Click the 'Finish' button, and a new window containing your U-MYX will open
7. Double Click on the U-MYX icon to start!

1. Double click on the .tgz file containing the U-MYX
2. A new folder will appear, double click on the folder's icon to open it
3. Double click on the U-MYX icon to start!
